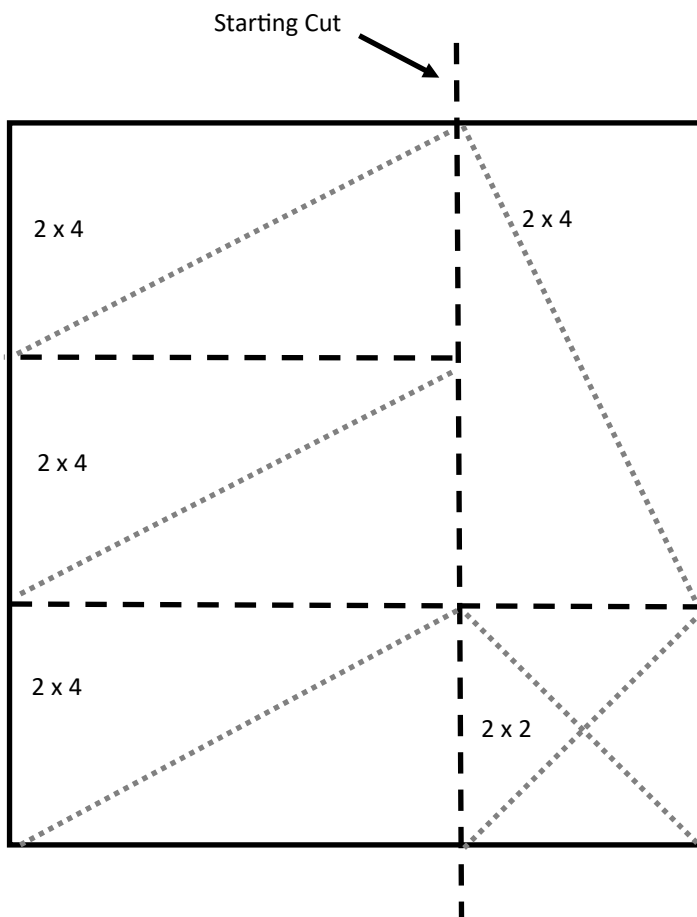


Free Two at a Time Cutting Guide



1. Cut the 6x6 starting sheet of paper at the four inch mark. Set the 2x6 inch piece aside.
2. Take the 4 x 6 inch piece and cut three equal 2x4 inch pieces from it (dashed lines.) Set all aside.
3. Take the other 2 x 6 inch piece and cut 2 inches off the end, resulting in a 2x2 inch piece. Set that aside for the end.
4. Take all four of the 2 x 4 inch pieces and cut in half diagonally from corner to corner, resulting in 8 skinny triangular pieces (dotted lines.)
5. Cut two card bases of 8.5 x 5.5 inches, folded in half to form card. Cut two background mats of 4 x 5.25 inches in coordinating cardstock, plus two more mats in white for the inside.
6. Adhere the triangles as shown on the samples. Trim excess from along edges. Adhere to card.
7. Create a focal point from stamps, ink and punches. Layer on right over the tips of the triangles.
8. Take the final 2x2 inch piece and cut that in half diagonally from point to point. Cut those two triangles each in half as well, giving you four corner pieces for the inside of the card.
9. Stamp and embellish as desired.
