Multipurpose Liquid Glue Stampin' Dimensionals™ Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder Heart of Elegance Dies



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- 1. To form the card base, score the Thick Basic White card stock at 5 ½ inches. Using your bone folder, give it a good crease.
- 2. Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere the Old Olive card stock first, then the Berry Burst card stock, to the card base.
- 3. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the card base, centering from top to bottom.
- 4. Locate the sheet of Designer Series Paper that features various drinks (see pic 1), and using your snips, fussy cut out two glasses (one tall and one short).
- 5. Die-cut the heart shape on the Timid Tiger card stock by using the next-to-largest heart die (Save the heart shape die-cut for another project if you want.)
- 6. Emboss the Timid Tiger card stock with the Plaster Painting 3D Embossing Folder.
- 7. Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, adhere the tall glass to the Timid Tiger card stock. Parts will hang over the die-cut, so be careful not to get glue there.
- 8. Adhere Stampin' Dimensionals to the small glass and adhere slightly to the left of the tall glass.
- 9. Adhere Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the Timid Tiger card stock. For the parts of the glasses that hang over, stack two Stampin' Dimensionals on top of each.
- 10. Center the Timid Tiger panel on the card base.
- 11. Stamp the sentiments in Berry Burst ink onto scrap Basic White card stock and fussy cut out. Pop up with Stampin' Dimensionals.
